## APPLYING FOR WESTCHESTER CIVIL SERVICE

- 1. Apply online with the Westchester County Department of Human Resources (civil service) to get on the appropriate list Librarian I, Librarian I (Children's Services), Librarian II, etc. There is a \$40 fee.

- 2. After you apply you will receive a letter saying you are eligible to take the "exam," which is really just an evaluation by way of a detailed questionnaire about the applicant's education, training and employment background. The higher the score the easier a permanent placement is, so elaborate as much as possible about all librarian duties and experience, plus all the conferences and training attended.
- 3. The scoring of the exam can take anywhere from 4-12 weeks. Any start date will depend on when the exam results are released and where you place on the Civil Service list for the exam you took (Librarian I, Librarian I (Children's Services), Librarian II, etc.).
