



Part-time Sunday Librarian - Adult Services

The Scarsdale Public Library has an opening for Sunday librarians in Adult Services. We are seeking flexible, patron-focused, energetic individuals for our busy Sunday afternoons. This position requires the ability to work a minimum of 2 Sundays per month from 12pm – 5pm or 11:30-5pm.

The Scarsdale Public Library is a bustling and lively hub of a community that values education and supports its library. It is a leading public library in Westchester County, consistently at the top of annual statistical rankings for numbers of visitors, programs and circulation of its collections. It is a member of the Westchester Library System, a consortium of 38 member libraries. - Assisting patrons in the discovery and utilization of library offerings
- Instructing patrons in use of library catalog, databases, and other electronic services
- Basic program coverage
- Assisting full-time librarians with special projects
